



- When setting the minute hand, advance it 4 to 5 minutes ahead of the desired time and then turn it back to the exact time.
- The 24-hour hand moves correspondingly with the hour hand (VX7J, VX7N, VX7R). When setting the hour hand, check that the 24-hour hand is correctly set (VX7J, VX7N, VX7R).
- HOW TO SET THE DATE



- Pull out the crown to the first click.
- Turn the crown counterclockwise to set the date hand to the desired date. 2
- Push the crown in. 3

NOTES

- The period of the set the date hand between 10:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. (VD75, VD76, VD86), or, 9:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. (VX7 series). Otherwise, the date may not change properly. If your watch is a LORUS LUMIBRITE watch, it has following features.

ORUS LUMIBRITE watches absorb and store ight energy from natural and artificial light ources and emit light in the dark. They are nade of environmentally friendly material, and herefore, are harmless to human beings and light therefore, are more environment.

- With a full charge, LORUS LUMIBRITE watches glow in the dark hours longer than conven-tional luminous watches of this type. If ex-posed to a light of more than 500 lux (i.e., the brightness of a typical office) for ap-proximately 10 minutes, or direct sunlight for 2 minutes, they will glow for hours.
- watches emit Since LORUS LUMIBRITE the since LORUS LUMIBILE wateres eminine light they store, the brightness will decrease gradually over time. The length of time they will glow may also differ slightly depending on such factors as the brightness of and distance the water distance from the charge the watch.

BATTERY CHANGE

The miniature battery SEIKO SR626SW (VD75, VD76, VD86) or SR927SW (VX series), which powers your watch should last approximately 3 years. However, because it is inserted at the factory, the actual life of the battery once in your possession may be less than 3 years. Be sure to replace the battery to prevent any possible malfunction as soon as it runs down. To replace the battery we recommend taking the watch to a local watch repair shop.
